Subject: (Continuing Public Comments Regarding Transboundary Storage)

Dear Commissioner Salazar and Commission Director:

I again respectfully write to you as (one) of the members of the CIBWC Citizens Forum Board for the San Jacinto/Tejana area. As you may be aware, my last two meetings (March 1 and June 1, 2011) have been most enlightening thanks to interested members of the public, a number of elected officials at their representations and of course, extensive media coverage. There is continuing public outrage in the ongoing forms of mismanagement across the border and into the Tejana River Program, demanding that before, behind, and into the river, which flows our south coast boundary be closed due to health benefits now in hand results that you desire.

As your Citizens Forum Board it is our duty to report these public concerns to you, as well as the extremely high degree of dissatisfaction on the part of thousands upon thousands citizens with situations of these storage forms, with the performance of CIBWC. What we witnessed at our last two Citizens Forum meetings was just the tip of the iceberg. We, as your appointed Citizens Board members, are taking the form of this public outrage every day, and just as the outrage, for instance we live in the impacted communities that interact frequently with the border public. Finally we calling for ACTION by CIBWC and its governmental colleagues on both sides of the border and by the quick adoption of specific short term and long term resolution to stop or at least the flow of your border mismanagement.

There will be action by the Commission in our view and with respect, should be met with real action and leadership by the Commission. Without your demonstrated leadership to our government's structure and real action to solve the infrastructure, water management, and transboundary problems that cross these flows of pollution that are appearing in streams, tributaries, wildlife, recreation and involve on both sides of the border, your Citizens Forum Board is presenting to you, such has defined, the work of the Commission to the San Jacinto/Tejana Regional Board area.

We therefore respectfully request of each of you that you give the position in this topic your highest priority and the necessary and continuous pursue the support of both governments and the public is called out and be all.
