It started as a simple politically motivated hit job. As reported by the *Reader's* Don Bauder, *San Diego Gay and Lesbian News*, published by Jonathan Hale (boyfriend to Republican city councilman Carl DeMaio), went after Michael Portantino, publisher of *Gay and Lesbian Times*, for alleged financial mismanagement. Around the same time, district attorney Bonnie Dumanis launched an investigation into possible circulation fraud at *GLT*. For his part, Por-

tantino is suing former employee Tim Marzullo for alleged breach of confidentiality. (*Gay and Lesbian Times* has frequently been critical of the current San Diego administration in general, and of DeMaio in particular.)

Then things got ugly. Approached by *SD on the QT* during a recent LL Bear night at Rich's, *SDGLN* editor-in-chief Ken Williams sniffed, "The *GLT*? Strictly *Flintstones* — 'We'll have a gay old time,' emphasis on the 'old.' We are the LGBT



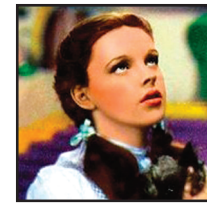

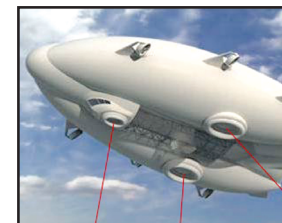


## Fire From Heaven

*U.S. Government's New "Death Blimp" Will Incinerate Illegal Border-Crossers with Precision Lasers Fired From the Edge of Space*

**"Who needs a wall?"**

In a historic collaboration between the U.S. Department of Defense, the U.S. Border Patrol, the U.S. Navy, defense contractor Lockheed Martin, and SPECTRE director Ernst Stavro Blofeld, a new super-blimp is being developed for use along the U.S.-Mexico border.\*

Following upon the successful deployment of several U.S. Navy-built surveillance blimps — which have proven to be capable of detecting the motion of a desert scorpion as it raises its poison tail to strike at one of its own young, to say nothing of illegal immigrants bent on destroying the American economy — *SD on the QT* has learned that the Pentagon has authorized Project Snoopy, a super-blimp that will make the move from simple surveillance to a rigorous enforcement of U.S. immigration policy.
