
2 3. The foregoing temporary support order is made without prejudice to either party. If either
3 party files a motion with the Court to review the issue of spousal support, the Court shall
4 determine the issue of spousal support on a de novo basis without consideration of this
5 temporary spousal support order. In such event, the Court shall have jurisdiction to make
6 any support orders retroactive to the date of filing of the applicable motion to modify this
7 order.

8 4. Facsimile and Duplicate Signatures. This stipulation may be executed on duplicate
9 signature pages to expediate the processing of the Stipulation. Facsimile or email
10 signatures shall be accepted in lieu of an original signature. All signatures pages shall
11 constitute one stipulation.






