SDOG 20 1. 21 submitted two separate written request to inspect and obtain copies of a certain public record in the 22 possession of Defendants/Respondents, but they failed to respond within the time permitted by law and 23 failed to produce a single responsive record. 24 **Parties** 25 2 SDOG is a non-profit organization formed and operating under the laws of the State of California. 26 27 3. Defendant and Respondent CITY OF SAN DIEGO ("CITY") is a local agency under 28 Section 6252(a) of the Act.

- 4. The true names and capacities of the Defendants/Respondents identified as DOES 1 through 100 are unknown to SDOG, who will seek the Court's permission to amend this pleading in order to allege the true names and capacities as soon as they are ascertained. SDOG is informed and believes and on that basis alleges that each of the fictitiously named Defendants/Respondents 1 through 100 has jurisdiction by law over one or more aspects of the public records that are the subject of this proceeding or has some other cognizable interest in the public records.
- 5. SDOG is informed and believes and on that basis alleges that, at all times stated in this pleading, each Defendant/Respondent was the agent, servant, or employee of each other Defendant/Respondent and was, in doing the things alleged in this pleading, acting within the scope of said agency, servitude, or employment and with the full knowledge or subsequent ratification of his principals, masters, and employers. Alternatively, in doing the things alleged in this pleading, each Defendant/Respondent was acting alone and solely to further his own interests.

Jurisdiction and Venue

- 6. The Court has jurisdiction over this action pursuant to Government Code Sections 6258 and 6259, Code of Civil Procedure Section 1060 *et seq.*, and Code of Civil Procedure Section 1084 *et seq.*
- 7. Venue in this Court is proper because the obligations, liabilities, and violations of law alleged in this pleading occurred in the City of San Diego in the State of California.

FIRST CAUSE OF ACTION: Violation of the California Public Records Act on May 2, 2013 Request (Against All Defendants/Respondents)

- 8. Paragraphs 1 through 7 are fully incorporated into this paragraph.
- 9. On May 2, 2013, SDOG caused to be submitted (via e-mail) a letter to CITY requesting certain public records as described in the letter ("May 2 Public Records Act request"). A true and correct copy of the request is attached to this pleading as Exhibit "A."
- 10. Under Government Code Section 6253(c), within 10 days of receipt of SDOG's May 2 Public Records Act request, CITY was required to determine whether the request, in whole or in part, sought copies of disclosable public records in CITY's possession and further required to promptly notify SDOG of the determination and the reasons therefor. Had there been unusual circumstances, the 10-day

time limit could have been extended up to 14 days by CITY through written notice to SDOG setting forth the reasons for the extension and the date on which the determination is expected to be dispatched.

- 11. CITY did not respond to SDOG's May 2 Public Records Act request within 10 days of receiving it.
- 12. CITY did not notify SDOG in writing that the response deadline for the May 2 Public Records Act request was being extended and therein set forth the reasons for the extension or the date on which a determined was expected to be dispatched.
- 13. The records responsive to SDOG's May 2 Public Records Act request are "public records" within the meaning of the Act. At no time did CITY ever invoke an exemption to disclosure of the records under the Act.
- 14. The time to produce the records responsive to SDOG's May 2 Public Records Act request has lapsed.
- 15. CITY's failure to respond to SDOG's May 2 Public Records Act request within 10 days was unlawful under the Act, and CITY's failure to produce disclosable public records responsive to the request was unlawful under the Act.
- 16. SDOG has been damaged as a result of CITY's unlawful failure to respond to the May 2 Public Records Act request and by CITY's failure to produce the disclosable public records responsive to the request.

SECOND CAUSE OF ACTION: Declaratory Relief under Code of Civil Procedure Section 1060 et seq. (Against All Defendants/Respondents)

- 17. Paragraphs 1 through 16 are fully incorporated into this paragraph.
- 18. SDOG is informed and believes and on that basis alleges that an actual controversy exists between SDOG, on the one hand, and CITY, on the other hand, concerning their respective rights and duties under the Act. As alleged in this pleading, SDOG contends that the public records responsive to SDOG's May 2 Public Records Act request are not exempt from disclosure under the Act and that CITY is required by law to produce them; whereas SDOG is informed and believes and on that basis alleges that CITY disputes SDOG's contention.
- 19. SDOG desires a judicial determination and declaration as to whether CITY was required to respond to SDOG's May 2 Public Records Act request, whether disclosable public records were

unlawfully withheld by CITY, and whether CITY was required by law to produce such records in a timely manner.

THIRD CAUSE OF ACTION: Violation of the California Public Records Act on May 3, 2013 Request (Against All Defendants/Respondents)

- 20. Paragraphs 1 through 19 are fully incorporated into this paragraph.
- 21. On May 3, 2013, SDOG caused to be submitted (via e-mail) a letter to CITY requesting certain public records as described in the letter ("May 3 Public Records Act request"). A true and correct copy of the request is attached to this pleading as Exhibit "B."
- 22. Under Government Code Section 6253(c), within 10 days of receipt of SDOG's May 3 Public Records Act request, CITY was required to determine whether the request, in whole or in part, sought copies of disclosable public records in CITY's possession and further required to promptly notify SDOG of the determination and the reasons therefor. Had there been unusual circumstances, the 10-day time limit could have been extended up to 14 days by CITY through written notice to SDOG setting forth the reasons for the extension and the date on which the determination is expected to be dispatched.
- 23. CITY did not respond to SDOG's May 3 Public Records Act request within 10 days of receiving it.
- 24. CITY did not notify SDOG in writing that the response deadline for the May 3 Public Records Act request was being extended and therein set forth the reasons for the extension or the date on which a determined was expected to be dispatched.
- 25. The records responsive to SDOG's May 3 Public Records Act request are "public records" within the meaning of the Act. At no time did CITY ever invoke an exemption to disclosure of the records under the Act.
- 26. The time to produce the records responsive to SDOG's May 3 Public Records Act request has lapsed.
- 27. CITY's failure to respond to SDOG's May 3 Public Records Act request within 10 days was unlawful under the Act, and CITY's failure to produce disclosable public records responsive to the request was unlawful under the Act.

28. SDOG has been damaged as a result of CITY's unlawful failure to respond to the May 3 Public Records Act request and by CITY's failure to produce the disclosable public records responsive to the request.

FOURTH CAUSE OF ACTION: Declaratory Relief under Code of Civil Procedure Section 1060 et seq. (Against All Defendants/Respondents)

- 29. Paragraphs 1 through 28 are fully incorporated into this paragraph.
- 30. SDOG is informed and believes and on that basis alleges that an actual controversy exists between SDOG, on the one hand, and CITY, on the other hand, concerning their respective rights and duties under the Act. As alleged in this pleading, SDOG contends that the public records responsive to SDOG's May 3 Public Records Act request are not exempt from disclosure under the Act and that CITY is required by law to produce them; whereas SDOG is informed and believes and on that basis alleges that CITY disputes SDOG's contention.
- 31. SDOG desires a judicial determination and declaration as to whether CITY was required to respond to SDOG's May 3 Public Records Act request, whether disclosable public records were unlawfully withheld by CITY, and whether CITY was required by law to produce such records in a timely manner.

Prayer

FOR ALL THESE REASONS, SDOG respectfully prays for the following relief against all Defendants/Respondents (and any and all other parties who may oppose SDOG in this proceeding) jointly and severally:

A. On the First Cause of Action:

- 1. A writ of mandate ordering Defendants/Respondents to promptly comply with the Act with regard to SDOG's May 2 Public Records Act request; and
- Preliminary and permanent injunctive relief directing Defendants/Respondents
 to respond to SDOG's May 2 Public Records Act request and to permit SDOG to inspect and obtain
 copies of the responsive public records.

B. On the Second Cause of Action:

- 1. An order determining and declaring that the failure of Defendants/Respondents to respond to SDOG's May 2 Public Records Act request in the time required by law and to permit SDOG to inspect and obtain copies of the responsive public records does not comply with the Act; and
- 2. Preliminary and permanent injunctive relief directing Defendants/Respondents to respond to SDOG's May 2 Public Records Act request and to permit SDOG to inspect and obtain copies of the responsive public records.

C. On the Third Cause of Action:

- 1. A writ of mandate ordering Defendants/Respondents to promptly comply with the Act with regard to SDOG's May 3 Public Records Act request; and
- Preliminary and permanent injunctive relief directing Defendants/Respondents
 to respond to SDOG's May 3 Public Records Act request and to permit SDOG to inspect and obtain
 copies of the responsive public records.

D. On the Fourth Cause of Action:

- 1. A writ of mandate ordering Defendants/Respondents to promptly comply with the Act with regard to SDOG's May 3 Public Records Act request; and
- Preliminary and permanent injunctive relief directing Defendants/Respondents
 to respond to SDOG's May 3 Public Records Act request and to permit SDOG to inspect and obtain
 copies of the responsive public records.

E. On All Causes of Action:

- 1. An order providing for the Court's continuing jurisdiction over this proceeding in order to ensure that Defendants/Respondents comply with the Act and all other applicable laws;
- 2. All attorney fees and other legal expenses incurred by SDOG in connection with this proceeding; and
 - 3. Any further relief that this Court may deem appropriate.
