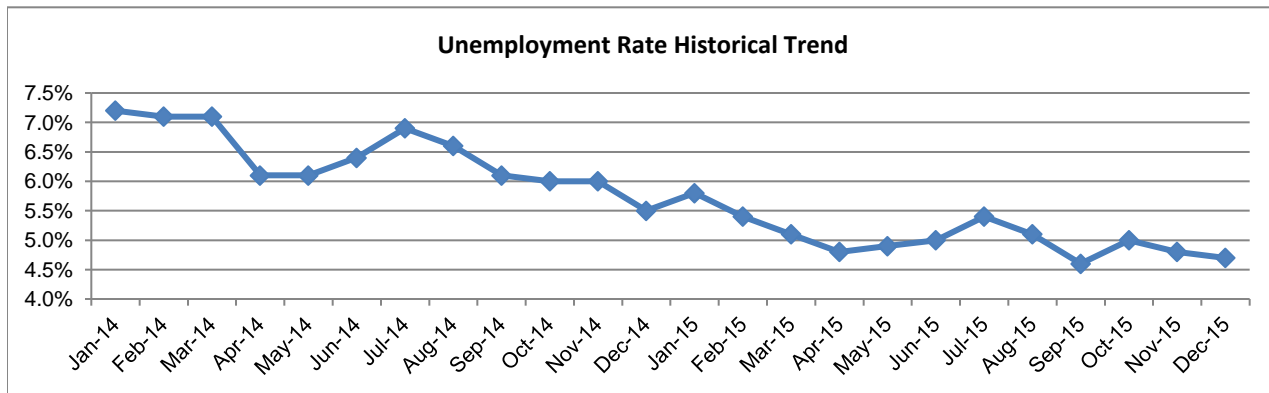


IMMEDIATE RELEASE  
 SAN DIEGO-CARLSBAD METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA)  
 (San Diego County)

The unemployment rate in the San Diego County was 4.7 percent in December 2015, down from a revised 4.8 percent in November 2015, and below the year-ago estimate of 5.5 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.8 percent for California and 4.8 percent for the nation during the same period.
