

IMMEDIATE RELEASE SAN DIEGO-CARLSBAD METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA (MSA) (San Diego County)

The unemployment rate in the San Diego County was 4.2 percent in March 2017, unchanged from a revised 4.2 percent in February 2017, and below the year-ago estimate of 4.9 percent. This compares with an unadjusted unemployment rate of 5.1 percent for California and 4.6 percent for the nation during the same period.
